### ***Driver License transcripts available for purchase from Clerk's Office***

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – August 10, 2007** – Pinellas County, Florida – Citizens can purchase copies of their driver license transcripts, which contain driver's history information, from the Clerk's Office beginning Monday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, Ken Burke, Clerk of the Circuit Court, announced today.

The Clerk's Office has contracted with the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) to offer this service, which was not locally available until now, according to Burke.

"Usually, when citizens find out they need their driver's license transcript, they don't know where to get a copy and they need it right away," said Burke. "Before, we had no way to offer them immediate access to their transcripts. People had to order them by mail from one of DHSMV's authorized providers."

There is an \$8.10 fee for a three-year history transcript and a \$9.10 fee for a seven-year history transcript. A person can only request and/or purchase their own driver license transcript and must present a valid form of identification with both a valid picture and signature, said Burke.

"We have worked for two years to make this happen, in order to save Pinellas County citizens a lot of time and effort," said Burke.

Driver license transcripts may be purchased at the Clerk's Criminal Court Customer Services Department located at the Criminal Justice Building, 14250 49<sup>th</sup> St., N., Clearwater; the North County Branch, located at 29582 U.S. 19 N., Clearwater; and the Clerk's Tyrone Branch, located at 1800 66<sup>th</sup> St., N.
