**One-on-One Florida, Bringing Together Local Attorneys
To Educate the Public About Bankruptcy
in Celebration of National Pro Bono Week**

(Pinellas Park) On Tuesday, October 25, 2011, Community Law Program, Inc. (CLP), a local non-profit legal services organization will host a free public forum to educate the general public about bankruptcy.
