Pinellas traffic offenders can pay fines at Amscot

ST. PETERSBURG, FL -- We already know Amscot is "okay with us!" Now the clerk of court is, too.

The Pinellas County clerk of court has partnered with Amscot to allow people with traffic court fees to make their payments quickly.

According to Ken Burke of the clerk's office, the county jumped on board because Amscot is conveniently located through out Florida and open 24 hours a day.

But Pinellas isn't the first county to make this move. Lydia Gardner of the Orange county first introduced the idea hoping to cut down the long lines at the court house, says Deveron Gibbons of Amscot. The partnership became so successful that Pinellas County decided to follow suit.

According to Executive Vice President, Ian A. MacKechnie, anyone can now pay Pinellas traffic citations and fines from any of the 170 locations starting June 1st.

Gibbons says that about 12 more counties have contacted Amscot looking to set up identical payment systems for their clerk offices including Sarasota, Pasco and Manatee.

Setting up the system between a county and Amscot take anywhere from four to six weeks. Amscot will charge a \$2.00 fee for the service.
