The Pinellas County Clerk's Office will begin accepting payments for Pinellas County traffic citations and fines at any Florida Amscot location beginning Sunday, Clerk of the Court Ken Burke announced. According to Burke, Pinellas County is the first to take court traffic payments through Amscot, which will charge a non-refundable \$2 fee for this service.
